

TRAIL DETAILS

- 2.9 mile long 10' wide concrete hike & bike trail from Lombrano St. to confluence at Apache creek
- 3 base bid street connections (Lombrano, Poplar, Guadalupe)
- 2 street connections selected at Arbor PI, Colorado St.
- Connects to Existing trail at Woodlawn Lake (North) and Apache Creek confluence (south)

- Construction start date February 17, 2020
- Preliminary Construction meeting conducted February 6, 2020



TRAIL DETAILS

- Joint Bid contract between SAWS and CoSA. SARA Managing hike and bike trail and park amenities.
- Trail connects to existing trails between Elmendorf lake and Cassiano park.
- Approximately 30% of trail has been placed
- Contractor is behind schedule
- Expected completion Summer 2020





TRAIL DETAILS

- Phase I Approx. 1.0 Miles long 10' wide concrete hike & bike trail from Knoke St. to Memorial St.
- Phase II Approx. 0.45 miles long 10' wide concrete hike & bike trail from Memorial St. to Alderete Park (add alternate)
- 8 overall trail street connections
- Bridge at 29th Street
- San Ignacio Trailhead









- Starting construction at Alderete Park Sta
- Concrete trails and retaining wall continuing east to 34th ST.
- Stormwater protection fencing being installed
- Preliminary grading started
- Concrete outfall structure demolition started
- Contract amount \$3,622,870.70


























































MARTINEZ CREEK TRAIL

DESIGN PHASE

- Design Completed April 2019
- 1.45 miles long 10' concrete hike & bike trail
- Ties to existing trail at Cincinatti (north) and Farias Park (south)
- 8 proposed street connections
- Bidding on hold due to SAWS sanitary sewer replacement project under construction along same creek areas.
 - Started January 2019
 - Scheduled completion for June 2021
