




TRAIL DETAILS

- Joint Bid contract between SAWS and CoSA. SARA Managing hike and bike trail and park amenities.
- Trail connects to existing trails between Elmendorf lake and Cassiano park.
- Project amenities to include shad structure, tables & benches, trash receptacles, drinking fountain, signage and ADA parking
- Remaining items for completion are vegetation, ADA parking spaces and Capstone.
- Substantial Completion will be scheduled when Capstone and ADA parking is complete.







TRAIL DETAILS

- Phase I Approx. 1.0 Miles long 10' wide concrete hike & bike trail from Knoke St. to Memorial St.
- Phase II Approx. 0.45 miles long 10' wide concrete hike & bike trail from Memorial St. to Alderete Park (add alternate)
- 8 overall trail street connections
- Bridge at 29th Street
- San Ignacio Trailhead









CONSTRUCTION PHASE - CONTRACTOR RCO, LLC

- Concrete trail continuous between Aldrete Park and Gen McMullen with exception of creek crossing and SAWS conflict at San Felipe
- Placed seeding on west end of project, landscape on hold due to theft.
- Construction of the San Ignacio trail head
- Mobilizing at 29th St for drill piers and foundation of pedestrian bridge and preparation of trail to Gen McMullen
- Final Completion April 27, 2021
- Contract amount \$3,622,870.70, per pay applications we are 49% complete.














ALAZAN CREEK TRAIL - PROJECT LOCATION













TRAIL DETAILS

- 2.9 mile long 10' wide concrete hike & bike trail from Lombrano St. to confluence at Apache creek
- 5 total street connections (Lombrano, Poplar, Guadalupe, Arbor PI, Colorado St.)
- Connects to Existing trail at Woodlawn Lake (North) and Apache Creek confluence (south)
- Awarded Contractor SpawGlass Civil Construction
- Construction start date February 17, 2020
- Expected end date Summer 2021
- Contract amount \$8,665,031.33

- Excavation occurring up to Travis St.
- New fencing along SAHA apts.
- Stone seating wall at Poplar St.
- Retaining wall construction on going
- Concrete installation up to Martin St.

DESIGN PHASE

- Design Completed April 2019
- 1.45 miles long 10' concrete hike & bike trail
- Ties to existing trail at Cincinnati (north) and Farias Park (south)
- 8 proposed street connections
- Bidding on hold due to SAWS sanitary sewer replacement project under construction along same creek areas. Construction completion expected by Jan 2021.

 - –GMP submittalSeptember 30







 - Splicing scheduled Aug 20










