

#### TRAIL DETAILS

- Phase I Approx. 1.0 Miles long 10'wide concrete hike & bike trail from Knoke St. to Memorial St.
- Phase II Approx. 0.45 miles long 10'wide concrete hike & bike trail from Memorial St. to Alderete Park (add alternate)
- 8 overall trail street connections
- Trailheads at the pedestrian bridge at 29<sup>th</sup> Street, San Ignacio and Alderete Park.
- Park amenities to include shade structures, drinking fountains, benches, signage, trash receptacles and solar lights at trailheads.











#### **CONSTRUCTION PHASE – CONTRACTOR RCO, LLC**

- Contractor was awarded substantial completion for hardscape on Dec 22, 2021.
- Contractor is currently working on vegetation establishment.
- Contractor has completed concrete trail, creek crossings and trailheads.
- Contractor is working on vegetation, park amenities, signage and the revegetation at SAWS conflict area to include concrete curb and sidewalk.
- Substantial completion expected in the next few weeks.
















#### **ALAZAN CREEK TRAIL - PROJECT LOCATION**















#### TRAIL DETAILS

- 2.9 mile long 10'wide concrete hike & bike trail from Lombrano St. to confluence at Apache creek
- 5 total street connections (Lombrano St., Poplar St., Arbor Place, Colorado St., Guadalupe St.)
- Connects to Existing trail at Woodlawn Lake (North) and Apache Creek confluence (south)
- Awarded Contractor SpawGlass Civil Construction
- Construction start date February 17, 2020
- Substantial completion date Feb. 2022
- Contract amount \$8,665,031.33













#### **CONSTRUCTION PHASE**

- Street connections are completed with stone pavement added.
- Last phases included landscaping and retaining wall painting & anti-graffiti coatings application.
- Railroad Bridge canopy was completed as part of last phase of construction.

# Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act

- Total Project Cost (Fed and Local) ~\$115M
- USACE Work Plan issued Jan. 19
- \$75,042,000 initiate physically complete, and fiscally closeout the construction project, including all future monitoring and adaptive management
- Funding will not flow through the River Authority, County or City
- SARA Local Sponsor
- Bexar County Project Funder (~35% share)

#### **Next Steps**

- Feb. 9 & 10 Fort Worth Project Delivery Team (PDT) toured full project
- City & County developing synergistic WSC area project ideas
- Negotiate Project Partnership Agreement (PPA) with USACE –
   Ongoing, target completion late spring/early summer
- After PPA has been signed, design is anticipated to take 18-24 months
- Anticipate outreach with the community, stakeholders and elected officials will scale up around Fall

- Additional Projects (BC Parks)
- Approximately \$240 million over 10 years

  - River Authority Board of Directors- December 15<sup>th</sup>

  - Outlines City of San Antonio, Bexar County, and River Authority Roles and Responsibilities within the program
- Task Orders
  - Project specific scope of work, budget, schedule, and procurement plan





# Task Order- Zoo Well

- Replacement and repair of existing well serving the SA Zoo
- **•**\$2,500,000
  - Previous \$1,500,000 from City of San Antonio
- 2 years to complete



#### Phase 1.2 Construction

- Poured pedestrian bridge between Alameda Theatre and AME site
- Upcoming pour of paseo adjacent to Alameda Theatre
- Took 3D LiDAR scan of AME foundations





#### Phase 1.3 Construction

#### Nueva to Cesar Chavez

- Installing subsurface structural support for Nueva bridge
- Poured concrete pilot channel, placing boulders in pilot channel
- Ongoing installation of stone block structural walls along west bank
- Pouring high paseo between Graham and Cesar Chavez

#### Bioretention pond



#### Phase 2 Construction

- Ongoing installation of subsurface structural support for Guadalupe bridge and north half of Alamo
- Beginning install of Guadalupe storm sewer
- Camp bridge deck poured
- Beginning installation of water line across Camp bridge





#### Phase 3 Construction

- Construction began in January
- Working on clearing vegetation and installing construction access ramps into channel
- Flaggers on Cevallos for temporary traffic stops








# Phase 1.1 *Creek Lines*


