Bexar County - Zarzamora Creek Trail Connection

- Design and construction of a 2.5-mile continuation of Zarzamora Creek Trail from Alderete Park to Tierra Del Sol Park
 - Including multiple connections with existing parks and street crossings with park amenities.
- Ongoing pre-design work including field surveys and environmental investigations
- 30% Design/PER expected December 2023
- Construction anticipated Fall 2024

San Pedro Creek



Question: Will a new trail be added to the other side of the creek?

Answer: In order to maximize the area for restoration, no new trail will be added to San Pedro, Apache, or Alazan Creeks.

Apache Creek



Question: How will the project make the concrete banks look better?

Answer: There will be opportunities for locally funded art separate from the project.

Question: How will the project fix flooding?

Answer: The Ecosystem Restoration project will maintain current flood control.

Martinez Creek



Question: Will there be a new trail to connect from Fredericksburg to the Beacon Hill trail?

Answer: New trail will be added from Cincinnati South to the confluence with Alazan Creek.

Example Creek Layout



- · Water surface elevation rises with increased vegetation
- Vegetation will be strategically located in the design to maintain the current water surface elevation



Examples of Cross Vanes, Constructed Riffles, and Pools



Vegetation Value

- Food for wildlife
 - Nectar, foliage, pollen, seeds, nuts, fruits, etc.
- Shelter for wildlife
- Soil and creek bank stabilization
- Filtration for water quality
- Shading
- Higher tolerance of heat, drought, and flooding











MAXIMILIAN SUNFLOWER





- Slackwater areas are portions of the creek with low velocities and shallow depths
- Important habitat area for aquatic organisms





Recreation Amenities

- Interpretive and wayfinding signs
- Shade structures
- Benches
- Water fountains
- Picnic tables
- Trash receptacles
